Remember, it is important to be kind to our pets.

## Things to Remember?

What can you do to care for your cat?

- ✓ All pets need food and water you can make sure your cat has fresh water every day and that you feed them the right kind of cat food. Make sure not to feed your cat human food as it can make them quite poorly
- ✓ Your cat will really love having a place to snooze or hide away. If your cat is in their favourite hiding spot then they may be feeling a bit scared or just need some time to themselves, so be sure to give them space and leave them alone.
- ✓ Some cats may not like being picked up and cuddled, so try not to grab them or hug them too tight. The only real way your cat can explain that they are unhappy is by scratching or biting, and they wouldn't want to hurt you by mistake just because they are uncomfortable with being picked up.
- Never hiss at your cat, you may think you are joking around with them, but to a cat it can be very upsetting. Remember we must always be kind to our pets.

When your cat is asleep, try not to disturb them. Even cats need quiet time sometimes.
