The Vetsure Kids Golden Rule

What this means is, if you would not pull your school friend's hair, then you also should not pull your dog's ears or tail.

Caring for your Dog

- All pets need food and water you can make sure your dog has fresh water every day and that you feed them the right kind of dog food. Make sure not to feed your dog human food as it can make them quite poorly.
- ✓ Your dog will really love having a comfy place to hide away. If your dog is in their favourite hiding spot then they may be feeling a bit scared or just need some time to themselves, so be sure to give them space and leave them alone.
- ✓ Some dogs may become upset if you put your face to close to theirs, in "dog language" it can mean that you are cross with them, so make sure not to do this to them.
- ✓ The only real way your dog can explain they are unhappy is by running away from you or if they can't get away, biting. They wouldn't want to hurt you by mistake, it is just because they are uncomfortable, so try not to hold on to them too tightly, especially if they are trying to get away from you.
- Never climb on or pull your dog around, you may think you are joking around with them, but to a dog it can be very upsetting. Remember we must always be kind to our pets.

When your dog is asleep or eating, try leave them alone.
