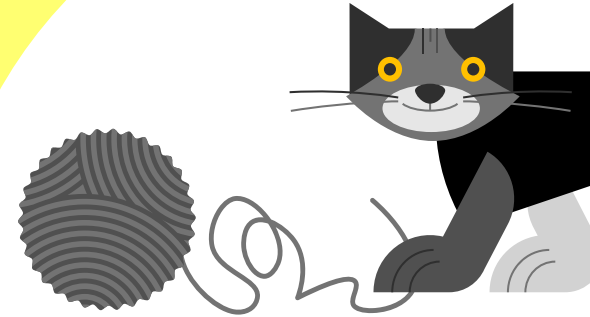
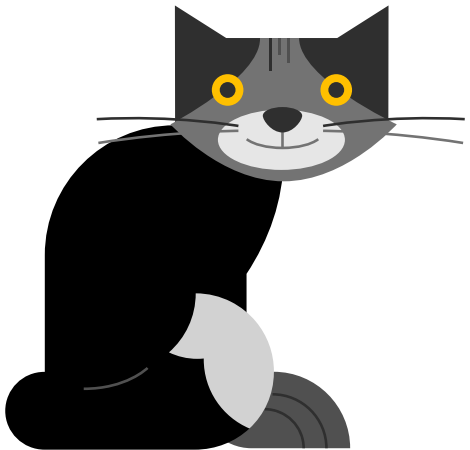




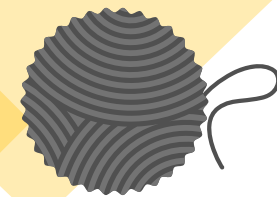

Some cats are born deaf, this means they have never been able to hear. Other cats may go deaf as they get older or due to their ears being poorly.

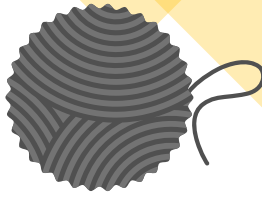
Deaf pets need a little extra help to keep them happy and safe.

It doesn't matter whether you have a deaf pet or one that can hear, every pet needs to be treated with kindness so they can live a happy healthy life.

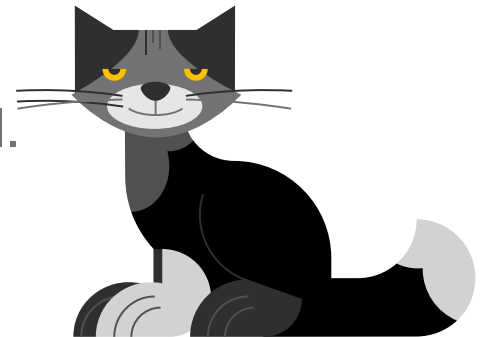
Being a best friend to your pet is a big job, but we know you can do it because you are a Vetsure Kid!

Remember, it is important to be kind to our pets.



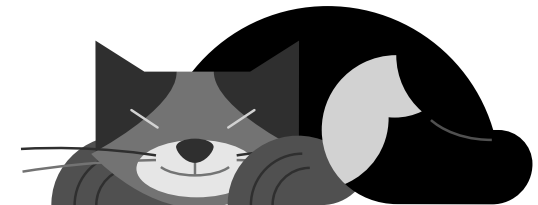
Things to Remember?

What can you do to care for your deaf cat?

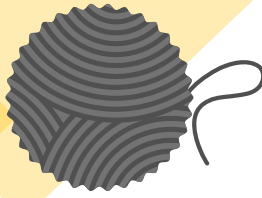
- ✓ All pets need food and water – you can make sure your cat has fresh water every day and that you feed them the right kind of cat food. Make sure not to feed your cat human food as it can make them quite poorly.
- ✓ A pet who is deaf can be more easily startled, this is because they cannot hear you coming. Scared pets may bite or scratch. Your pet doesn't want to hurt you, they are your best friend, so it is important that your deaf pet can see you coming or knows where you are before you touch them.
- ✓ Your cat will really love having a place to snooze or hide away. If your cat is in their favourite hiding spot they may be feeling a bit scared, or just need some time to themselves. Be sure to give them space and leave them alone.
- ✓ Some cats may not like being picked up and cuddled, so try not to grab them or hug them too tight. The only way your cat can explain they are unhappy is by scratching or biting, and they wouldn't want to hurt you by mistake. This is just because they are uncomfortable with being picked up.
- ✓ Sometimes it is important to keep deaf pets inside, this is a decision your adult can make. This is because pets with hearing problems can't hear traffic which could be unsafe.



When your cat is asleep, try not to disturb them. Even cats need quiet time sometimes

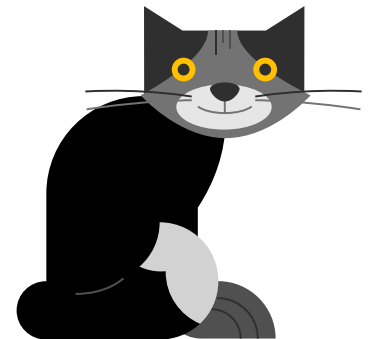
