

- A dog who is deaf may be more easily startled, this is because they cannot hear you coming.
 Scared pets may bite but your pet doesn't want to hurt you, they are your best friend. It's important that your deaf pet can see you coming or knows where you are before you touch them.
- ✓ When training your pet with a hearing problem, a good plan is to use hand signals. You could point at the ground to let them know you want them to "lay down", and that way your pet can understand what you want them to do.
- On walks it may be a good idea to keep a dog with hearing problems on a lead. Remember, they can't hear cars coming, or you calling their name to come back. Keeping them on their lead will stop them wandering into danger or getting lost.
- ✓ All pets need food and water you can make sure your dog has fresh water every day and that you feed them the right kind of dog food. Make sure not to feed your dog human food as it can make them quite poorly.
- ✓ If your dog is in their bed, or in a favourite quiet spot then they may need some time to themselves, so be sure to give them space and leave them alone.
