


Kittens are the same, they don't play sport or paint pictures, but some kittens may like sleeping all the time and some may like climbing trees. Every kitten is different!


Kittens may all be very different but there is one rule that can be used for all of them:

Remember, it is important to be kind to our pets.








#### Things to Remember?

#### What can you do to care for your cat?



- ✓ Your kitten will really love having a place to snooze or hide away. If your kitten is in their favourite hiding spot then they may be feeling a bit scared or just need some time to themselves, so be sure to give them space and leave them alone.
- ✓ Try not to grab them or hug them too tight. They are only small babies, and you could hurt them if you are too rough. However, make sure you give them lots of love and play with them!
- ✓ Never hiss at your kitten, you may think you are joking around with them, but to a small kitten in a new home it can be very upsetting and scary. Remember we must always be kind to our pets.
